Your guide to enrolling in Kindergarten 2025 at Rutherford Public School



Working together for a successful transition to Kindergarten

Eager Eagles 'Flying Start' is a transition program for children who will be commencing Kindergarten at Rutherford Public School in 2025.

Your child will attend one of the two Thursday sessions: Session 1 - 9:15am to 11:15am Session 2 - 12:30pm to 2:30pm

Eager Eagles 'Flying Start' is coordinated and run by experienced and qualified Teachers and School Learning Support Officers. The program is free.

The play-based sessions will focus on school readiness, school environment and staff familiarisation. Activities target fundamental skills and language development.

These will include:

- Individual, small group and whole group activities
- Indoor and outdoor activities
- Hands-on activities as well as structured learning
- Stories
- Art and Craft, songs, dancing and drama

In the long term, the Eager Eagles 'Flying Start' program aims to:

- Develop positive attitudes towards coming to school for the children
- Enable children to feel comfortable and familiar in the school environment

WHAT TO BRING



- Comfortable clothing:
 - Eager Eagles t-shirt (supplied)
 - shorts/pants
- Closed in shoes (Velcro preferred)
- Bag (school bag size) for belongings and craft creations etc
- Drink bottle filled with water only
- Fresh fruit or vegetables for fruit break (no snacks, no nut products)
- Sun hat and sunscreen
- Toys are best left at home as they may get lost or damaged
- Children are to be signed in and out of each Eager Eagles 'Flying Start' session by a responsible adult
- **PLEASE LABEL EVERYTHING.** All items need to be clearly marked with your child's name





Complete your child's NSW Public School Application to Enrol in an NSW Government School online using the QR Code below.

If you are unable to access or complete the online application, please contact the school office on 4932 5900 to make alternative enrolment arrangements.

Upload your supporting documents including your child's Birth Certificate, Immunisation History Statement and 100 points Residential Address to the online application.

Applications can be saved and completed any time within a 30 day period of beginning the process.

The enrolment and registration process must be completed before your child begins the Eager Eagle 'Flying Start' program.

Finalise enrolment

On completion Rutherford Public School administration staff will contact you to finalise all paperwork.

You will be required to attend the office and sign the enrolment form.

Register your child for our Eager Eagles 'Flying Start' Program.

Once all paperwork for the school enrolment has been completed, an email will be sent to you to complete the Eager Eagles 'Flying Start' registration form.

On completion of the registration form you will be contacted with your allocated Eager Eagle 'Flying Start' session.
