Adjectives are words that describe a noun!




In this picture, our noun is the dog. If I wanted to describe something about him, I could write



Sunflower Craft



You will need:

- Yellow paper (Colour white if you need to)
- Green paper (Colour white if you do not have any)
- Brown Card it can be cardboard packaging (Recycle/Reuse)
- Scissors
- Glue

Procedure:

- 1. Trace your handprint six times on the yellow paper and cut them out.
- 2. Draw a thick stem and two leaves on the green paper and cut them out.
- 3. Draw a large circle (trace a lid) on the brown paper and cut it out.
- 4. Draw some lines starting from the centre outwards like seeds.
- 5. Assemble the yellow handprints and glue them together or use tape.
- 6. Stick the brown seed circle on top of the handprint petals.
- 7. Join the stem and leaves to your creation.

















A map shows us where we are and where we need to go. They show us what is around us.

Printing with Flowers

Materials:

- Paint (including green)
- 1 paint brush
- Paper
- Flowers of various shapes and sizes from the garden. Daisies work best, but any shaped flower will work.



Steps:

- 1. Collect flowers of various shapes and sizes from the garden.
- 2. Use green paint to paint some stems onto your artwork.
- 3. Press flowers into paint. Place flowers at the end of the painted stem to print them.
- 4. Repeat until all stems have a flower on the end of them.
- 5. You can add leave by pressing leaves into green paint and printing them next to the stems.
- 6. Put artwork somewhere safe to allow the paint to dry.


Alternative: You can paint a vase with the stems coming out of the vase.

<u>You will need:</u> Basket Rolled up socks


How to play:

The Colour of Sound

What do you hear?

Materials: Pencils, common household objects

Time: 30 minutes



Listen:

Go for a 'sound hunt' around you home and look for everyday items that make a noise. Books, pencils, zippers, dried leaves, scrunching paper, different pots and pans and water bottles all can be tapped or moved to make a noise. Your job today is to listen to the sounds that these things make.

Go around the house and find your favourite sounds to use. Think about how each sound is differentor the same. What sort of sound does the object make? Is it a swooshing sound, rough sound, smooth sound or rattling sound?

Play:

Grab a couple of the items that you used and create a short pattern.

For example, you might play: Zip, zip, stomp on the floor, pencil tap

Practice your pattern until you can repeat it over and over.
