Your record sheet can look like this, blank out when you knock all the pins down and start a new game.





### Materials:

- Paint (red, yellow, blue)
- paint brush
- Paper

### Steps:


- 1. To create the shell of the snail, paint circle in the middle of the page using your first colour.
- 2. Paint a larger circle around the first circle using your second colour.
- 3. Paint a larger circle around the circle using your third colour. When painting the circles, be careful not to mix the colours.
- 4. Paint the snail's head and eyes. You can use any colour for this.



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





# Maps


Today we are going to try learning some Auslan to sing a song called 'I can Sing A Rainbow'. You can watch the video link to learn the hand signs and then have a try yourself.
