1. Vice President

The Vice President is responsible for:

- Ensuring that the P&C Association takes part in decision-making processes in the school
- Fostering fair participation of all members and ensuring that all new members are made to feel welcome
- Supporting volunteers
- Consistent adherence to the constitution
- Acting as the P&C Association's spokesperson when public statements or actions are needed if the president is not available
- Setting up lines of communication with the Principal
- Being signatory on the Association's bank accounts
- Chairing meetings, in the absence of the President

2. Canteen Committee Member

The Canteen committee oversees the day-to-day operation of the school to ensure the canteen meets the policy requirements. The canteen committee meets every month, one week prior to the P&C meeting on a Monday afternoon.

a nomination form. The positions will be filled at the next P&C meeting on Tuesday 13th September at 6:30pm.

I always enjoy reading student writing. It is wonderful to see the pride students' take in their work.

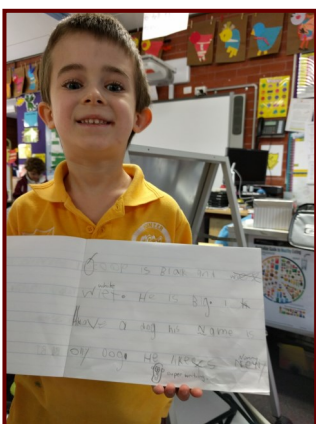
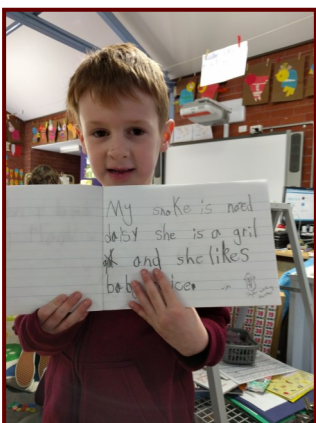

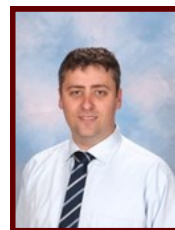

BOOK FAIR

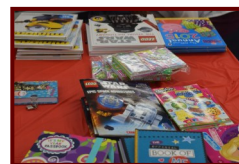
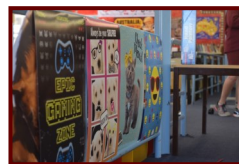
This week is Rutherford Public School's Book Fair. By Monday afternoon, every child in the school will have had the opportunity to visit the library to create a wish-list of books or other reading-related items they would like parents to consider purchasing for them. This is, of course, not compulsory. I do, however, wish to take the time to again comment on the benefits of reading and how events like these can strengthen or help to develop a love of reading in our children.

Reading is the single most important skill a child will learn at school, and while many children have developed reading skills, further development depends on using these skills regularly.

Please take the time to talk about the selections of books your children come home with on their wish-list. This can give you great insight into the style of writing they enjoy to read, what genre might appeal to them, or even who their favourite author is. As parents, we can model to our children how much we value reading by having conversations around features of different books.

If your child does not bring home a wish-list, don't panic! You can still have this conversation with them. Also, having a wish-list is not necessary in coming to buy a book from us, or from borrowing a book from your local library, nor from the school library.

Please, take the time this week to talk to your children about books



as we will be doing the same at school!

WHAT INFLUENCES THE SUCCESS OF TRANSITION?

Research shows that successful transitioning to high school is dependent on several factors including:

- Academic preparation: higher levels of school readiness makes learning easier.
- Emotional stability: happier young people are more likely to adjust to learning in a new environment.
- Ability to make friends: those students who make friends easier find school more enjoyable.
- Family situation: supportive family environments help students to prepare and adjust to new situations.
- Sense of belonging: young people who feel like they 'fit in' tend to adjust easily to a new school environment.
- Family - School Cooperation: good working relationships between families and the school can help support transition.
- Resilience: students who can handle change undergo less- stressful transitioning.

Young people need different types of emotional and practical support when transitioning depending on their age and maturity.

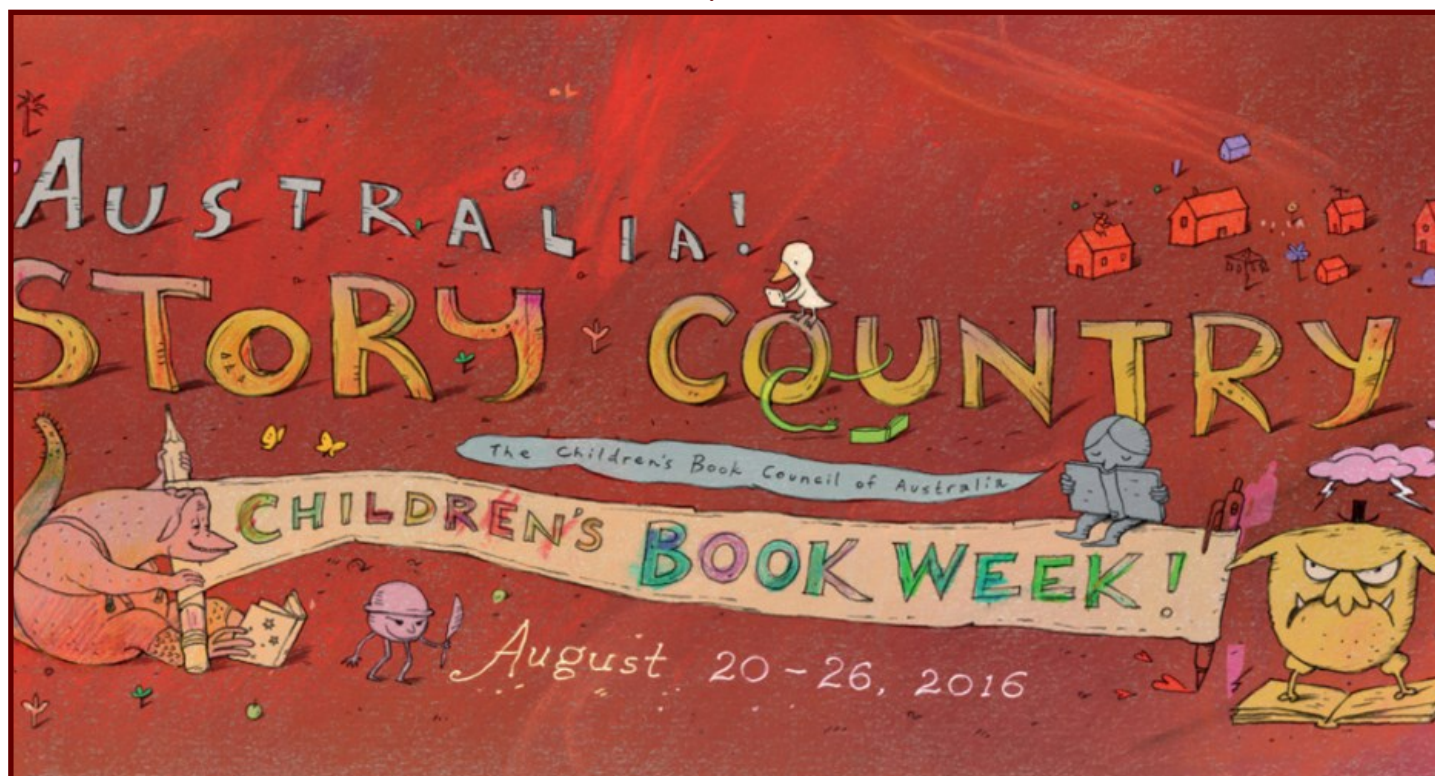

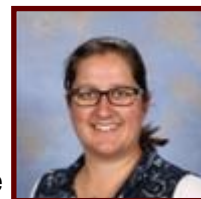

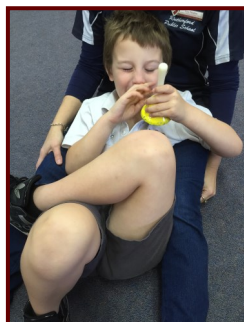


...S1 Exploring the Community...
