From the Principal ...

MOBILE PHONES

Last week I spoke to Stage 3 students about mobile phone use in the school and use in general. Mobile phones are fast becoming a standard accessory for modern day life. I understand that parents are choosing to purchase mobile phone technology for their children for various reasons (e.g. safety, access to the internet and gaming).

Whilst I understand the benefits of mobile phone ownership, young children must be closely monitored and educated on how they should use such devices.



I spoke to the students about how a person's privacy is very important to protect. Children must be made aware of how quickly they can become victim to identity theft, unwanted photo-sharing and potentially put them at risk of harm. Recent media reports tell us that young people are getting into trouble by sharing too much information about themselves with friends and even unknown people.

Rutherford Public School allows children to have mobile phones with them for before and after school use but the following rules are applied during all school hours (including before school and after school and bus lines).

- No phones are to be used in the playground or classrooms without the permission of the class teacher or school executive.
- No photos or videos can be taken or recorded on a device during school hours.
- Students using mobile phones will be asked to hand over the phone to the principal, and the phone will be secured until the end of the day.
- Students not following the mobile phone procedures may be suspended for ongoing misuse and non-compliance.

Where a parent needs to contact their child for messages, they should do so by calling the office. Where the child should need to contact parents, they should do so by reporting to the school office and an assessment will be made by the office staff whether parents will be contacted.

New technology brings amazing opportunities for us all. Parents and educators must ensure that such opportunities bring positive learning experiences. Supervision and education are the keys to success!

MRS KERRY FERGUSON TO RETIRE

Mrs Kerry Ferguson (Assistant Principal) informed the Department of Education last week that she plans to officially retire next month. Currently on leave, Mrs Ferguson has been at Rutherford Public School since 2003.

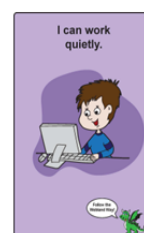
